A PROCLAMATION

Week for Elimination of Unnecessary Noises

WHEREAS, the excess of noises constitutes a serious menace to public health and to the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the unnecessary noises affect the good name of our country as civilized people who have achieved a high cultural level;

WHEREAS, the respect for the fellowbeing's right to live a quiet life should lead us to cooperate toward the better enforcement of the laws prohibiting unnecessary noises;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week from October 15 to 22 of this year as Week for Elimination of Unnecessary Noises, and I request from all my fellow-citizens their full cooperation in this campaign which I trust shall form permanent habits of consideration to the fellowbeing's tranquility, which shall thus result in great benefit to the Puerto Rican community. And I ask all vehicle drivers and the owners and operators of jukeboxes, radios and television sets to coordinate their efforts for the complete success of this campaign; and I urge all businessmen of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to exercise their good judgement as citizens in planning their advertising campaigns, so that the same do not result in bigger noises.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed, at the City of San Juan, this 14th day of October, A. D., nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
