> > AN EXECUTIVE ORDER

Additional Holidays for the Employees of the Government of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico during the Festivities of Christmas, New Year and Three Kings Day

WHEREAS, Friday, December 24 and Friday, December 31st are Christmas and New Year's Eve respectively, and Wednesday, January 5 comes before Three Kings Day;

WHEREAS, the above mentioned periods are workable days on which every public employee is compelled to work;


WHEREAS, during these workable days that come before the Christmas, New Year's and Three Kings legal holidays, there prevails in our country a marked inclination to celebrate the traditional festivities of the Christmas Season, and the government employee naturally identifies himself with the prevalent Christmas spirit;

WHEREAS, a great number of the employees of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico lives outside the metropolitan area where are located the majority of the government agencies where they work;

WHEREAS, it is convenient that government employees be given the opportunity to enjoy more fully the various activities undertaken during these traditional festivities;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority in me vested by law, DO HEREBY DECLARE as holidays for the employees of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, its public agencies and instrumentalities, the afternoons of the following workable days: Friday, December 24, 1954, Friday, December 31st, 1954, and Wednesday, January 5, 1955. The heads of all governments units herein included shall take necessary measures to keep the minimum personnel needed in their respective agencies to attend to any urgent matter that may be brought to the attention of

same according to the needs of public service.
