A PROCLAMATION

Engineer's Week

WHEREAS, The College of Engineers of Puerto Rico, as well as their colleagues in other parts of the world, intend to celebrate Engineer's Week during the period from February 21 to 27, 1954;

WHEREAS, distinguished members of the College of Engineers collaborate, either from official positions or from the private practice of their profession, with the effort that the people and the Government of Puerto Rico are carrying out for the benefit of all the inhabitants of the Island;

WHEREAS, so much is owned by all of us to the comparatively few, who make up this profession, who have pioneered, developed and brought to fruition many of the vast benefits to our economic, industrial, and social wellbeing, through the protection to life, health, and property, in the development of natural resources, ways and means of transportation, water, power, light, sanitation, and communication; and

WHEREAS, the assitance of engineers in our progress shall be more essential every day, due to the accelerated process of our development;

WHEREAS, it is fit to make official the celebration of Engineer's Week;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the days between February 21 to 27 as Engineer's Week and urge all my fellow citizens to honor the engineer class by all means possible, and to give it the acknowledgement it deserves for its contribution to the development of our Island.
