A PROCLAMATION

Homage to the Aged

WHEREAS, the aged, because of their experience and spiritual serenity, are a source of wise counsel and generous orientation for the people that have the privilege of having them in their midst;

WHEREAS, the Legislature of Puerto Rico designated through Act Number 24 of April 27, 1933, the third Friday of April of every year to pay homage to the aged;

WHEREAS, the third Friday of this year falls on the religious observance of good Friday; it is, therefore, advisable that the homage to the aged be celebrated one week in advance;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim Friday, April 9, 1953, as the day of this year in which to pay homage to the aged, and call upon the people to evidence, through adequate acts and ceremonies, their love and respect to all those persons who have attained a long life surrounded by the affection and consideration to which they are entitled for their works and exemplary citizenship.
