A PROCLAMATION

Girl Scout Week

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the period of March 6 to 12 as Girl Scout Week, and March 12 as the Forty-Third anniversary of its organization in the United States of America, and I ask all the citizens to lend their cooperation and assistance to the Girl Scouts of Puerto Rico, in the present as well as in the years to come, so that the Organization may continue its progress in benefit of Puerto Rico's youth.
