BASEBALL WEEK


WHEREAS, it is our government's objective to promote sports because of their valuable contribution to our youth's moral and physical development;

WHEREAS, baseball has become Puerto Rico's most popular sport, and constitutes a sound pastime of every citizen;

WHEREAS, said sport demands from its participants their fullest cooperation, all together with a salient individual behavior, encouraging in them a high sense of comradeship and solidarity as well as their personal initiative;

WHEREAS, baseball thus aids in forming good citizens conscious of the duties and rights of each individual and society in a democracy;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week of March 19 to 26 as Baseball Week, and I urge the Public Recreation and Parks Administration, the schools, recreational associations, the press, radio and television to emphasize the importance of this sport in promoting democratic attitudes in our youth.
