A PROCLAMATION


Centenary of Rosendo Matienzo Cintrón

WHEREAS, April 22 of this year will mark the centennial of the birth of the prominent thinker and politician Rosendo Matienzo Cintrón;

WHEREAS, Rosendo Matienzo Cintrón struggled with earnest civic determination for the discontinuance of large landowning and absenteeism; proposed the country's industrial development; indicated the need to diversify agricultural production; encouraged the establishment of production and consumption cooperatives; worked towards reducing illiteracy; and fought for more extended liberties for the Puerto Ricah people;

WHEREAS, Rosendo Matienzo Cintrón dedicated his life to the affirmation of the Puerto Rican personality, and fore-saw the inter-American position that Puerto Rico would some day have in relation to the other countries in the Hemisphere;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, proclaim the year 1955 Year for Commemorating the Centenary of Rosendo Matienzo Cintrón, and I urge the University of Puerto Rico, the schools, the civic and cultural institutions, the press, radio and television, and all citizens to pay homage to this illustrious fore-seer of Puerto Rico's future, and to make known the wisdom of his works because of its valuable contribution to our historic making.
