A PROCLAMATION


Fire Prevention Week, 1955

WHEREAS, carelessness and ignorance cause annually a tragic loss of lives, homes, natural resources and production means which can be prevented;

WHEREAS, it is necessary that we double all our efforts for the prevention of fire, so as to avoid such unnecessary losses;

WHEREAS, for such purposes we should carry out a civic educational program to show the people the effective means to prevent fires, and impress in their minds the tragic consequences of careless actions which may start fires;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the week from October 9 to 15, 1955 as Fire Prevention Week, and I urge all government agencies, schools, the press, radio and television, civic organizations and all the citizens to join the fire prevention campaign undertaken during that week.
