

A PROCLAMATION

Registration of voters of both sexes for the General Elections of November, 1956

WHEREAS, in accordance with Act No. 19 approved on June 10, 1939 establishing a system of registration of voters, as amended by Act No. 1 of February 13, 1952, I gave my approval to the resolution of the Commonwealth Board of Elections setting Saturday January 28, 1956 and Sunday January 29, 1956 for the registration of voters of both sexes that have not registered for the general elections corresponding to the year 1956;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, pursuant to the provisions set forth in said act, do hereby announce through this proclamation that registration of female electors shall take place on Saturday January 28, 1956 and registration of male electors shall take place on Sunday January 29, 1956 in Puerto Rico, starting at one o'clock each day, so as to register during those days all those individuals of both sexes who have never registered as voters and who legally have the right to register to be able to vote in the general elections corresponding to the year 1956.
