A PROCLAMATION

Week of the Puerto Rican Family


WHEREAS: The entire Puerto Rican community, specially its civic, political and intellectual leadership, is aware that the stability and welfare of the family is of great importance to the country;

WHEREAS: The Commonwealth Government recognizes that, for the attaining and maintenance of the highest level of welfare of the Puerto Ricans, it is necessary for them to enjoy a happy home life, for which there have been established, and are being established, enlarged and improved every day, more programs for strengthening family life;

WHEREAS: The Puerto Rican community should be alert to the need of joining efforts to attain the highest level of stability and happiness of the Puerto Rican homes;

WHEREAS: We should make efforts to offer our youth opportunities for an adequate guidance as to their duties in married life and parenthood, so that future generations may free themselves, to the utmost, of personality conflicts causing unhappiness and destruction of so many homes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby declare the period from June 23 to July 1st., 1956, as Week of the Puerto Rican Family, and I request from all public officials, industries, civic, religious and professional groups, private citizens, and very specially the youth, their whole-hearted cooperation in the acts to be held during said week under the sponsorship of the Institute of Family Relations, to develop in the young people a greater consciousness of the need to be adequately prepared for marriage and family life.
