
A PROCLAMATION

Press Week, 1956

WHEREAS, by Act No. 126, approved May 6, 1940, and subsequently amended, the Legislature of Puerto Rico set apart, in perpetuity, the week starting on the 1st. day of July of each year, as "Press Week", directing the Governor to remind the people to observe said week; and

WHEREAS, Press Week aims to stress the importance of Puerto Rico's Press, so that the public may have a full understanding of what the press means to the general progress of the community, and duly appreciate the worthiness of those who devote their lives to striving for collective culture and advancement through the field of constructive and honest journalism;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby remind all the inhabitants of Puerto Rico that the week of July 1st. to 7, 1956, has been designated by law as "Press Week" this year, so as to stress the importance of the press in Puerto Rico by means of appropriate acts and ceremonies, and I urge all departments and other Commonwealth divisions, as well as all social and civic organizations of this country, and the people in general, to give their most enthusiastic cooperation towards a greater success of the activities that may be held during said week to carry out the purpose of the law.
