A PROCLAMATION


Orientation Day on Heart Diseases, 1956

WHEREAS, heart diseases constitute the first cause of death in Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico Heart Association is engaged in an educational program on the prevention and treatment of the cardiac ailments, and for the improvement and broadening of the facilities for their diagnosis and treatment;

WHEREAS, the Puerto Rico Heart Association shall launch a campaign to collect funds during the month of July, 1956;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby urge all the inhabitants of this Island to show their interest in combating heart diseases, by lending their support to this campaign, thus helping the Puerto Rico Heart Association to carry out its vital program. And I further proclaim July 15th., 1956, as "Orientation Day on Heart Diseases", urging all public and private institutions to dedicate some time of this day to instruct the public on the means to fight said diseases.
