
A PROCLAMATION

Date for Holding the 1956 General Elections

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico directs that elections should be held every four years, starting on the year 1952; and

WHEREAS, the Registration and Voting Act of Puerto Rico directs that the Governor should announce through a proclamation the date for the holding of such elections;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby announce and proclaim that on Tuesday, the 6th. day of November, 1956, elections will be held in all electoral precincts in Puerto Rico for the election of public official as authorized by law.
