

A PROCLAMATION

Holiday for the Public Schools

With the purpose of fixing up the schoolrooms that will be used as election polls in the general elections to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 1956, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby declare Monday, November 5, 1956, as a holiday for the public schools of Puerto Rico.

I urge, furthermore, those private institutions, such as hospitals, hotels, and restaurants, which because of the nature of their business will continue their operations on the holiday Tuesday, November 6, to make the pertinent arrangements in order to facilitate their employees their arrival at their respective voting polls for the due exercise of their privilege to vote on election day.
