A PROCLAMATION

ALIEN ADDRESS REPORT MONTH

WHEREAS, the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952 requires that every alien in the United States, except diplomats, persons officially connected with international organizations of which the United States is a member and those admitted temporarily as agricultural laborers, report his address during January of each year; and

WHEREAS, this law requires such an address report though the address of the alien has not changed since the last report; and

WHEREAS, Address Report Cards may now be obtained at any United States Post Office or Immigration Service within this Island;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, in recognition of the importance of compliance with the law to future citizens of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the month of January, 1960 as

ALIEN ADDRESS REPORT MONTH

in Puerto Rico and request all citizens, employees, and officers of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to assist and encourage every alien within the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to report his address at the nearest Post Office or Immigration Service Office during the month of January, 1960.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to be affixed at San Juan, Puerto Rico, this 31 day of December, A.D. nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.
