

A PROCLAMATION

Mother's Day

WHEREAS, the second Sunday in May of each year has been designated Mother's Day in Puerto Rico, by Act number 25, of 1915, which also commissions the Governor of Puerto Rico to remind the people of Puerto Rico of the observance of this day;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUNOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby take pleasure in reminding to the inhabitants of this Island, that Sunday, May 8, is the day designated by law as Mother's Day this year to honor home and motherhood; to honor the memory of dead mothers and to bring joy to those who are alive, by expressing our love, by appropriate services in churches and other religious and civic organizations, and by displaying the emblematic honeysuckle, suggested by our Legislative Assembly, as an emblem of rejoicing in the exalted ideal commemorated on this day.
