## About the City of Silence


WHEREAS, there are in Puerto Rico a number of children unfortunate enough to be congenital deaf-mutes;

WHEREAS, the existing facilities for bringing hope to these children, though efficient and praiseworthy, are limited;

WHEREAS, a group of citizens has undertaken the commendable task of launching a campaign for the construction and equipment of the City of Silence, an educational institution devoted to teaching these children to speak;

WHEREAS, the Government of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico acknowledges with sympathy every educational effort made for our people, particularly for our children.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUNOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim the months of July of this year and of 1961, as campaign months devoted to the City of Silence, and I urge all my countrymen to cooperate within their means to this praiseworthy work, so as to alleviate the state of despair and silence in which these Puerto Rican deaf-mute children live.
