A PROCLAMATION

Social Workers' Week

WHEREAS, the Social Work Profession in Puerto Rico has developed greatly during the last twenty years that have elapsed since its practice was officially authorized by law;

WHEREAS, the College of Social Workers of Puerto Rico commemorates its twentieth anniversary;

WHEREAS, the Social Workers have made a valuable contribution to the effort of the Puerto Rican people to raise their standard of living and civilization;

WHEREAS, it is understood that a good civilization is one who promotes the full enjoyment of the social, economic, political and spiritual resources necessary to the achievement of human dignity;

WHEREAS, the Social Work is worthily represented in every government agencies.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim July 18-24, 1960 as Social Workers' Week, in public recognition of the work done by Social Workers, and their contribution to the attainment of our people's present standard of living. And I furthermore urge them to continue, with an ever-increasing dedication, in their daily contribution to the social renovation of our people.
