A PROCLAMATION


Doctor's Day

WHEREAS, the physician is, in his ministrations, in the practice of his science to benefit mankind, a symbol of faith, hope and kindness, thus deserving the love and respect of his fellow citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 4, as Doctor's Day, and I urge all my countrymen and their civic and representative organizations to offer physicians the recognition deserved by their devotion to the service of others.
