A PROCLAMATION


Telephone Operator's Day

WHEREAS, the service rendered by telephone operators to the government, private enterprises and also to the general public, aids these institutions in fulfilling their duties effectively and promptly, and helps in the communication of the whole country;

WHEREAS, telephone operators perform a work of great importance and responsibility, offering their services all day and night, thus establishing an efficient communication and allowing the carrying out of many matters requiring promptness and secrecy;

WHEREAS, during emergencies caused by natural disasters, telephone operators are always ready to handle the necessary aid and rescue by attending to the calls for help, thus establishing contacts with those who may answer to these distress calls;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUÑOZ MARIN, Governor of the Common-wealth of Puerto Rico, by virtue of the authority vested upon me by law, hereby proclaim September 22, as TELEPHONE OPERATOR'S DAY, and I urge all Government Departments and Agencies, and private entities and my fellow citizens in general, to attend all such activities as may praise the work of these operators so worthy of public acknowledgement.
