A PROCLAMATION


Heart Disease Orientation Day: 1960

WHEREAS, heart diseases constitute the main cause of death in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

WHEREAS, the Asociación Puertorriqueña Para Combatir las Enfermedades del Corazón (Puerto Rican Anti-Heart Disease Association) has launched an educational program on the prevention and treatment of this group of diseases and for the improvement and expansion of facilities for their diagnosis and treatment;

WHEREAS, the Asociación Puertorriqueña Para Combatir las Enfermedades del Corazón will initiate an educational campaign to disseminate information and collect funds during the month of October, 1960;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUIS MUNOZ MARIN, Governor of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, do hereby urge all my fellow citizens to show their interest in the fight against heart disease by supporting this campaign and thus contributing to the realization of the program of the Asociación Puertorriqueña Para Combatir las Enfermedades del Corazón. And I furthermore proclaim October 15, 1960 as Heart Disease Orientation Day, and request public and private institutions to devote part of their time during this day to inform the people on the means of fighting said diseases.
